Summary

Artistic Swimming World League KIDS - a competition for the younger age group of **athletes U8 & U10**. World League KIDS will be held on December 13 2025 right before the general event.

The events of the World League KIDS are run under the special rules for each category, while the AS World League is held by the latest WA Rules competitions with International and Local Award Opening Ceremonies' split.

The sports program of the **World League KIDS** includes the competition in Free events.

The purpose of the World League is to promote peace, respect and unity of athletes and people all around the globe. The League fosters the idea of nations equality, and accessibility of participation in elite sports events despite the nationality, race or religion.



The third edition of the **Artistic Swimming League** will be held in Dubai, on December, 13-17 2025 employing the biggest sports arena in the Mena Region- Hamdan Sports Complex.

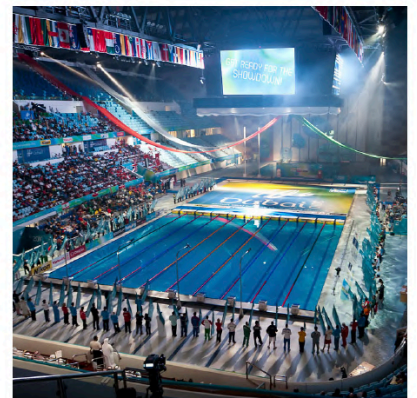


COMPETITION VENUE

Hamdan Sports Complex is one of the biggest in the world multi-purpose sports arena located in Dubai, United Arab Emirates. The complex has three indoor pools suitable for both competition and training purposes in all the Aquatic Sports.

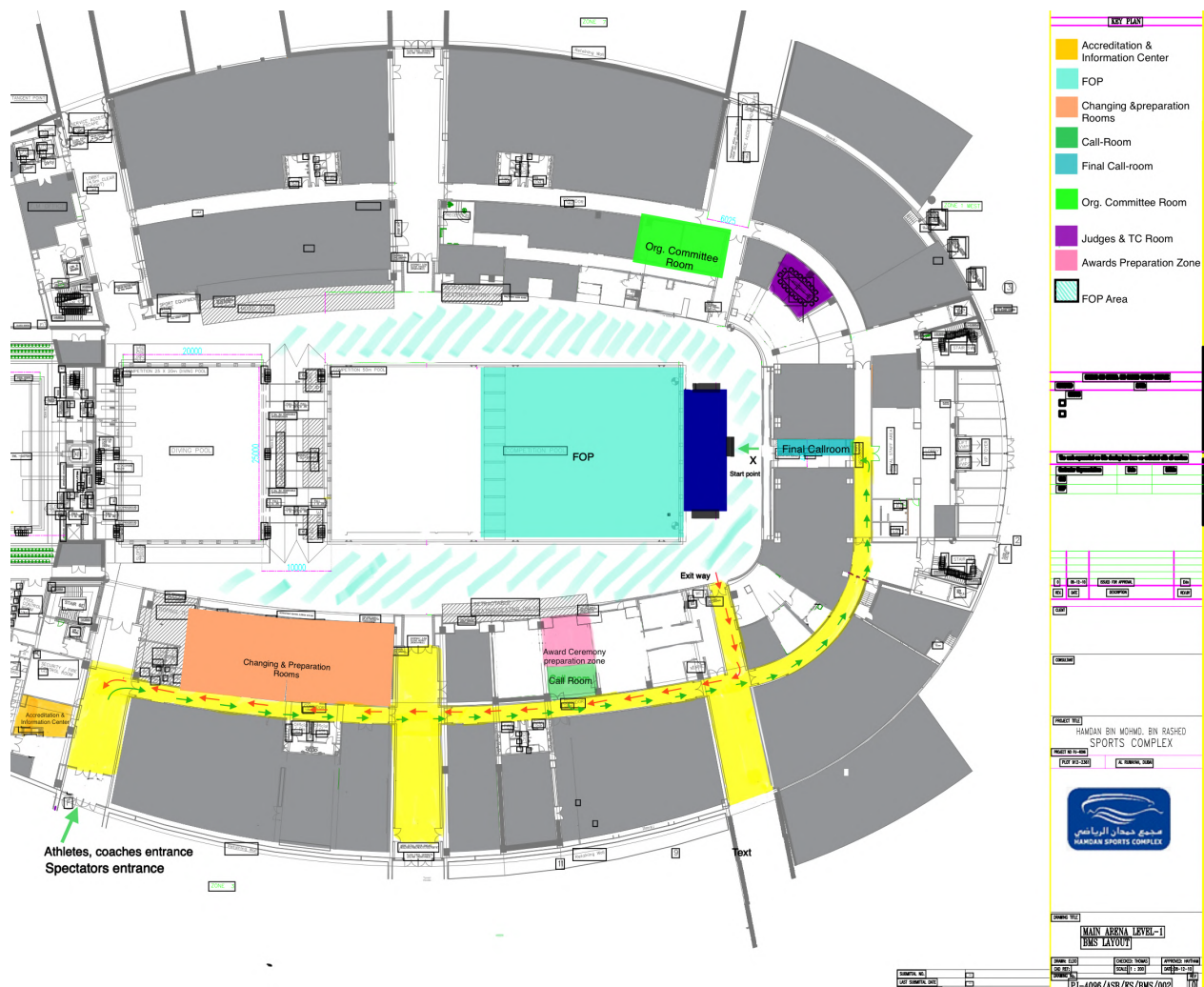
Hamdan Sports Complex swimming and diving pools are of Olympic standards. Boasting two 50-meter swimming pools, and the advanced technology of moveable floors, the swimming pools can be transformed into 25-meter pools at differing depth.

The competition will take place in 50m pool, and 3m depth, Equipped with underwater cameras and underwater sound system.





Venue Overview



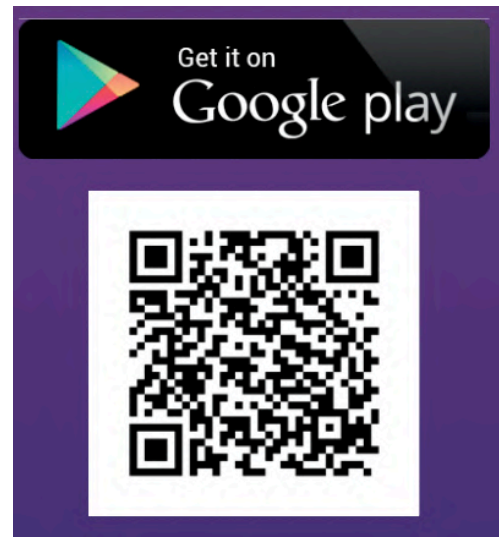
Information Desks

Information Desks will operate at the entrance of the venue throughout the competition. Information Desks will provide information on the competitions staged at the venue and will be in operation from the first day of the training.

Operating hours for the Information Desks will be from 08:30 to 20:00 from Dec 13 to Dec 16, 2024.

Access to the Information Desks will be given to accredited Team Officials only to ensure that information is communicated efficiently and effectively to all delegations. Information on the World League can also be obtained from the app "Sportity". This app can be downloaded from the following QR code.

Once downloaded, press on the arrow on the left top side of the screen, and tap to add an event. Then insert the password **lamachampionofASWL2025**

Lost & Found

All reports of lost items should be directed to the Information Desk located at the Athlete's Lounge. This is also the location to which all found items should be delivered.

Mixed Zone

Mixed Zones are restricted areas at competition venues where athletes are required to pass. They allow the press and broadcast media to meet athletes for quick interviews on their performance. Athletes are not obliged to stop and talk to the media, however, they should be aware that there are few opportunities for the media to meet athletes, except in the Mixed Zones or at Press Conferences.

Team Leaders' Meeting

At the Team Leaders' Meeting, important details of the competition will be presented. Participation is mandatory for all National Federations and Clubs, and if a representative is absent, it is subject to a penalty fee of one hundred dollars (100\$). The Team Leaders' Meeting will include the following:

- Roll-call
- Flow of Athletes
- Sports Information Desk
- Warm-Up Procedures
- Safety Procedures



- Press Interviews
- Draw of Entries

Team Leaders are responsible to check all given personal details and spelling of the athletes' names. Changes may not be accepted after the meeting. The Team Leaders' Meeting **date & time is TBC.**

Changes to Entries

As per the World League Competition Regulations, any changes of the names of the competitors from the most recent entry lists must be handed to the Referee in writing at least two (2) hours prior to the published start time of routine number one (1). Changes after this can only be made in case of sudden illness or accident of an athlete and if the reserve is ready to compete without delaying the competition. The final decision in such a situation shall be made by the Referee.

Call Rooms

At the end of the warm-up period, athletes are asked to go to the Call Room at least three (3) routines prior to their start number. Athletes with start numbers one (1) two (2) and three (3) must report to the Call Room 20 minutes prior to the start time of the first routine.

Before/During and After the Routine

Athletes are to remain in the Call Room until escorted to the Field of Play on point. Athletes will be directed by the Sport Presentation Manager when to line up for entry onto the Field of Play. Athletes will be introduced before they commence their routines as they approach the starting position near the entry platform. A maximum of two (2) team coach/ officials per National Federation will be permitted on the Field of Play to view the routine of their athletes. Team officials must be dressed appropriately in their National Federation/Club Uniform when on the Field of Play.

After the routine, the athletes must join their coaches and wait in the designated location for their scores.



Accreditations

All the athletes, and member of each delegation must receive the accreditation once first entered the Venue (Hamdan Sports Complex). All athletes must present their accreditation card when reporting ready at the Call Room prior to their event. The Sports Presentation Manager will verify the credentials against the start list.

Field of Play Protocol and Access Control

Clean Field of Play policy will be implemented during the competition. For this reason, only the staff and official's integral to the operation of the event will be permitted at or around the Field of Play.

Similarly, no personal or non-essential equipment will be permitted at the pool deck during the competition. All athletes and team officials are asked to respect the need for a clear deck policy during the competition by ensuring only competing athletes are on the Field of Play. Access to the Field of Play will be strictly limited to persons with the correct accreditation, hence the athletes and the team officials are required to always wear their accreditation card where appropriate.

Entry to the Field of Play

During the competition all athletes must enter and exit the Field of Play through the designated athletes' entrance. The athletes and team members who are not participating in the competition must respect the space to assure that only the competing athletes are in the competition area and follow the guidelines given by the organizers and volunteers.

Exit from the Field of Play

Once they complete their swim, the athletes will leave the water and proceed to a designated position on the entry platform (Kiss & Cry) and wait on this position for their scores are being announced. Athletes will then exit the Field of Play via the Mixed Zone.

Timing, Scoring and Results

After the successful competition of each event, and official results release, the files will be distributed to teams via the mobile application Sportity.



Events

Free Solo, Free Duet, Free Team, Combination Team

Age Groups

Under 8: 2017 and younger
Under 10: 2015, 2016 year of birth

Number of entries per category:

Each delegation has a right to enter maximum of 1 Duet, 1 Solo, 1 Team, 1 Combination per the Age category.

*Additional routine: In case the delegation wishes to have +1 routine in the same Age category it is possible via paying an additional fee of 100\$ for each routine applicable

(Max routines from the delegation at the same category are two)

Officials

The competition will be held by the World Aquatics Artistic Swimming Rules;

The delegation with 8 athletes and more must provide 1 Judge/TC

The Judge shall be trained for the judge/ controller position.

Dress Code:

All the Officials must wear black pants, light sports shoes and the Official Events T-Shirt.

The T-shirt will be distributed upon arrival.

Insurance/medical services

Professional medical services will be provided as needed. All participants are responsible for having a valid insurance coverage against accidents, illness and other risks. Organizers are not responsible for any liability in case of accident; however, the first aid will be available at the venue medical stations.

MEDAL CEREMONIES

The Medal Ceremonies will be held at the competition venue Main stage. Following the presentation of medals, athletes will participate in a parade around the Field of Play, where applicable.

All finalists shall wear their National Federation/Club uniform with appropriate footwear (sports shoes) during the Medal Ceremony and lap until they leave the Field of Play arena. Athletes will be briefed about ceremony procedures in the assembly area. Not coming prepared with full uniform may create delays event schedule.

Items such as flip flops, flags, caps, mobile phones, or any other symbols in addition to the national kit **are not allowed on the podium.**

The Award Ceremony Categories

The Award Ceremony Categories list will be announced in November 2025.

1st, 2nd, 3rd place receive Awards, Medals and Gifts

* All UAE clubs have a privilege to compete in 2 categories Local and International

** *Special and sponsors gifts will be presented to all participants*

Athletes, Coaches, Team Managers Dress Code

All the participants of the ASWL 2025 shall enter the competition venue wearing a National Federation/Club uniform at all the times.

Warm up: athletes must wear caps and swim suits with the National Federation/Club identity.

Media

All the event is covered by Media Team including local and international media channels. All the athletes **are strongly encouraged to take part** in the Interviews, and other media activities conducted by the media team of the ASWL 2025.
